AccuCare is on the Way!

AODS has contracted with Orion Healthcare Technology to implement the AccuCare Web Based System for SUD treatment providers. The system will support the use of the Addiction Severity Index (ASI) and the ASAM Assessment. AODS wants to enhance the use of technology for providers and offer new and improved tools that will help with efficiency and workflow. Training and implementation will be taking place once providers have submitted the necessary documents to the Orion team

American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) E-Modules

In a contract with The Change Companies, AODS has purchased three ASAM E-Modules to support required training for Substance Use Disorder treatment providers. There are three e-modules, "Introduction to the ASAM Criteria", "Multidimensional Assessment" and "From Assessment to Service Planning". This online training function will assist treatment staff who are providing direct clinical services to beneficiaries in the Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System. AODS Forms Update

Five (5) AODS forms are in the final stages of approval and should be distributed to SUD providers within the next two weeks. The forms include the revised American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) Criteria Placement Assessment (AODC-011), revised Intake/ Admission Form (AODC-005), revised Treatment Plan (AODC-010) and a new Discharge Plan and Discharge Summary.
