COMPLIANCE CORNER

Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) Requirements for the Period of 2022–2026—Behavioral Health Information Notice No: 21-075 Minimum Quality Drug Treatment Standards and for DMC/ODS Document 2F(a) Regarding the Discharge Plan.

- **Requirement:** Documentation should reflect that the Discharge Plan was prepared within 30 DAYS PRIOR to the last face to face session.
- **Issue:** During our reviews, it has been found that the chart has documentation the Discharge Plan was prepared on the day of discharge. This is technically incorrect.
- **Purpose:** The idea is meet with the client for a least one (1) discharging planning session within 30 days of the scheduled discharge. This leaves room for additions /changes, etc. The Discharge Plan should be reviewed and signed at discharge. The exception to this is if there is an unplanned discharged. If this is the case, then the Discharge Plan is created and signed by beneficiary in a final individual session.

In addition the following must be provided to the Beneficiary:

- The required Informing Materials
- Resource List
- Copy of the Discharge Plan to the beneficiary and file one in the chart.
- Lastly, thoroughly document the session and discharge the beneficiary the same day. The discharge date is always the same date as the last date of service.
